On January 18, we invite any and all interested community members to engage in a second opportunity to participate in the Linda Beach Playfield master planning process.

At the first meeting on November 16, 2017 the City of Piedmont introduced the landscape architecture firm Groundworks Office who has been chosen to work on the development of the Linda Beach Playfield Master Plan. The intent of the project is to create a conceptual plan to meet the present and future needs of the City of Piedmont within the context of the neighborhood, the needs of the community and the constraints of the existing site. With the exception of the field itself, all areas from the Oakland Avenue Bridge to Beach School and between Howard and Linda Avenues will be on the table for possible enhancements, improvements and renovations.

Groundworks will be presenting three initial concepts for Linda Beach Park based on the comments from the first community meeting in November. All attendees will then have the opportunity to participate in table work sessions to provide comment and input on the concepts. We want to hear your ideas. Please join us on **Thursday, January 18 from 5:30-7:30** in the Piedmont Community Hall, 711 Highland Avenue, Piedmont, CA. Children are welcome to attend and participate.
