Notice is hereby given that the following measure is to be voted upon at the General Municipal Election to be held in the City of Piedmont on Tuesday, the 3rd day of March, 2020.

MEASURE ____ “Shall Ordinance 746 N.S, which maintains essential police, fire, and paramedic services, prevents the reduction in maintenance of City parks, greenspaces and other public areas, and prevents the loss of recreational and other public services, by renewing the City of Piedmont’s expiring parcel tax for four years, with annual rates depending on use between \$551 and \$1,395 per parcel, or \$383 per dwelling unit, subject to CPI adjustment, raising approximately \$2,424,620 annually, be adopted?”	YES

NOTICE OF LAST DAY FOR FILING ARGUMENTS

Notice is hereby given that the last day for filing direct arguments for or against the preceding measure is December 13, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. Each argument shall comply with the California Elections Code and shall not exceed three hundred (300) words in length.

No more than five (5) persons may sign any argument. If an argument is submitted by an organization, the name of the organization and the name of at least one of its principal officers shall appear at the end of the argument.

All arguments should be filed with the office of the City Clerk, Piedmont City Hall, 120 Vista Avenue, Piedmont, CA 94611.

The last day for filing rebuttal arguments shall be December 20, 2019 at 4:00 p.m., and all such rebuttal arguments shall be filed with the office of the City Clerk, Piedmont City Hall, 120 Vista Avenue, Piedmont, CA 94611. Each rebuttal argument shall comply with the California Elections Code and shall not exceed two-hundred fifty (250) words in length.
