Seating in the City Council Chamber will be limited, as guests will be required to sit arm's length from one another.

If necessary, overflow seating will be provided and safe distancing practices will also be followed in the overflow spaces.

Additionally, the City is asking members of the public to consider these <u>Steps to Prevent Illness</u> when deciding whether to attend a meeting. The City is asking members of the public to follow the <u>California Department of Health's Guidance on Mass Gatherings</u> when deciding whether to attend a meeting.
